Home to the **McNair Center for Aerospace Research and Innovation at the University of South Carolina**, offering aerospace education, cutting-edge research and industry engagement.

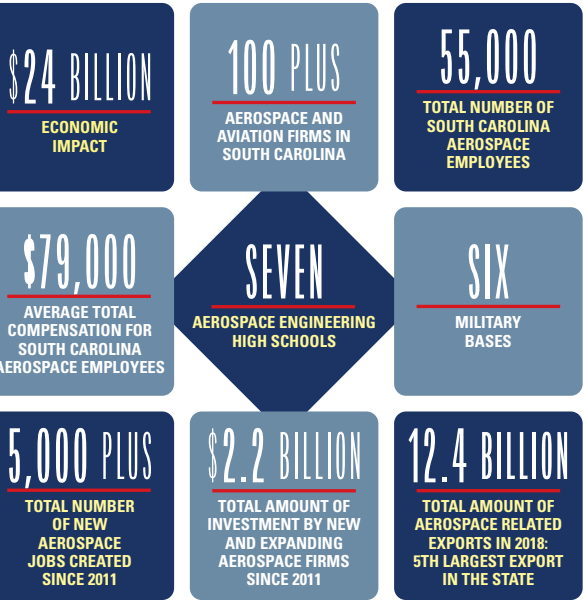
